Welcome to the RAF Lyneham Flying Club (LFC). LFC aims to provide first class flying training and aircraft hire in high quality aircraft at the lowest price possible. The Station Commander has kindly granted permission for LFC to operate and we are very fortunate to be able to use the many facilities provided by RAF Lyneham. If these privileges are to be maintained, all LFC members must agree to abide by the LFC Flying Order Book (FOB), the Health and Safety at Work and the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations and with any other rules, regulation orders & bye laws which the LFC Committee may promulgate from time to time.

You will be training towards the JAR Private Pilot's Licence (PPL) and your progress throughout the course will be recorded within the folder kept in the club. The document which details the JAR PPL syllabus, training prerequisites, licence entitlements and privileges is JAA FCL 1. You will need to acquire some training manuals to support your learning while on the course, we suggest you acquire 2 of the books immediately, those being "The Air Pilot's Manual" Volumes 1&2, these are written by Trevor Thom and are available from Amazon. In due course you will need to have access to volumes 3 and 4. You must purchase a recognized flying logbook (this is a legal requirement) and later in the course you will need to purchase a CAA VFR chart to plan navigation exercises. Your first solo might be closer than you think and before you can be sent on your own you must have completed the air law exam and have a CAA class1 or class2 medical certificate, therefore it would be prudent to complete the exam and medical examination as soon as possible. You should now have been issued with a Flight Schedule Pro account allowing you to book aircraft and instructors 'on-line', however, as our instructors are all part time, you will need to arrange with the chosen instructor by phone an agreeable time before booking the aircraft.

Finally, may I wish you every success during your flying course with LFC. The application form for a PPL will be provided to you when you complete your first written exam and before long you will be submitting it to the CAA for licence issue. There are some vastly experienced and highly qualified members of our club, who will do anything they can to help you achieve what is probably a long held dream...
